Trek Little Tibet

17 Days Trekking in the stunning Markha Valley of the Greater Himalayan range in Ladakh, India.

If you are looking for an unforgettable Himalayan adventure this trek is for you. Ladakh forms one of the most elevated areas of the world the majestic snow-capped peaks of the Himalayas towering over the patchwork of green village fields fed by glacial snow melt. Ladakh is also one of the last places where Tibetan Buddhism continues to be practiced as a living religion, as it has been for a thousand years. This tour provides a wonderful introduction to the region. You visit a number of Buddhist monasteries, traditional homes, and villages as you trek into the remote and beautiful Markha Valley.

Season: June to September

Trek Grade: Moderate to Difficult.

- Day 1: Arrive in Delhi and Overnight stay.
- Day 2: Early morning flight to Leh. Day to relax and acclimatize.
- Day 3: Visit to Spitik and Phyang Monasteries.
- Day 4: Day at leisure and individual activities.
- Day 5: Visit to Stok Palace & museum.
- Day 6: Walking tour to Sankar village and Leh Palace.
- Day 7: Trek begins, from Spitik to Zingchen.
- Day 8: Zingchen to Yurutse
- Day 9: Yurutse to Skiu
- Day 10: Skiu to Markha village.
- Day 11: Markha to Tahungtse.
- Day 12: Tahungtse to Nimaling
- Day 13: Nimaling to Shang Sumdo
- Day 14: Sumdo to Hemis, drive to Leh via Thiksey & Shey.
- Day 15: Fly to Delhi, Drive to Agra.
- Day 16: Visit the Taj Mahal and Agra Fort. Drive to Delhi.
- Day 17: Tour ends after breakfast, flights home !
